

# AusDiagnostics Sample Exchange Program (ASEP) 2017

## Outline and Schedule

#### Introduction

The AusDiagnostics Sample Exchange Program (ASEP) is being run again for 2017. AusDiagnostics clients are invited to participate in any or all of this years program by sending an expression of interest to the address below. This years program will focus on *Easy*-Plex<sup>™</sup> faecal pathogens and pneumonia kits. The program will be run on a quarterly basis (alternating between faecal pathogens and pneumonia). Please note that the variety of the pathogens included in the program is **fully dependent on participant contributions.** 

Each participating member of the sample exchange program will be asked to send 3 samples; see below. We would like 1 negative clinical sample and 2 positive clinical samples.

- All positive samples should include at least one target with a take-off value of between 5-15 cycles
- The negative sample should be negative for all pathogens on the panel used

Each member of the exchange program will be responsible for sending the samples to AusDiagnostics along with covering the postage costs.

AusDiagnostics will confirm that the samples received are useable and post a set of diluted sample aliquots back to each participant in a blind study.

#### Faecal Pathogens

Participants should prepare the 3 stool samples in STAR buffer. You will be asked to extract this using your normal extraction procedure and analyse the nucleic acid extracts on the Easy-Plex System or other systems in use.



#### Pneumonia

Participants should send 3 Nucleic Acid extraction samples after extraction. Further instruction including preferred buffer and targeted pathogens will be discussed closer to Q2.

We will collate all the undisclosed participants results and return a simple result findings report.

#### **Expression of Interest**

Your expression of interest is to be done through the filling in of an online registration form (separate for each ASEP run) including the information on:

Your expression of interest correspondence email should include information on:

- The name of your laboratory and contact details.
- ASEP programs you are interested in (Faecal Pathogens and/or Pneumonia).

- Any pathogens samples relevant to the suggested AusDiagnostics products along with your current or preferred transport medium (as mentioned previously the variety and strength of pathogens and samples included in the exchange program is fully dependent on participant contributions).
